Penn State Harrisburg - Academics


- Only campus, along with University Park campus, to offer academic programs from freshman to doctoral levels



Fall 2016 enrollment of over 700 international students from 45 different countries.





Graduate/Undergraduate Enrollment





Full-Time/Part-Time Enrollment





Percent of Enrollment by In-State/Out-State







Faculty and Staff

- Faculty complement of 371; 241 full-time and 130 part-time
- Complement of 295 full-time staff
- Faculty productivity in 2014-15 includes 149 journal articles, 28 creative works, 11 books, 347 conference presentations, with a total of more than 600 pieces of research, scholarship, and creative work
- Research conducted with graduate and undergraduate students
- Our intellectual capital – through research, scholarship, and expertise – is the basis for our external engagement.
- Our faculty bring in \$5 - 7 million in new research grants every year.
- Multiple research centers and institutes are housed on campus.


