


#### Penn State Harrisburg - Academics

- Robust and growing Honors and International Programs






#### **Student Enrollment**

Fall 2016 enrollment of over 700 international students from 45 different countries.







# **Graduate/Undergraduate Enrollment**







# Full-Time/Part-Time Enrollment











#### Percent of Enrollment by In-State/Out-State








