






WHAT IS PENNDOT CONNECTS?

- A holistic approach to planning to...
 - Support a community's vision.
 - Increase efficiency and cost-effectiveness.
 - Ensure the best allocation of resources.

PennDOT and planning partners **invest in communities** by **engaging local governments** *prior* to developing project scopes and cost estimates to discuss details for each project.

VALUE OF MUNICIPAL PARTICIPATION

- Municipalities can communicate the transportation needs of their community – such as those related to safety, mobility, and the environment – now and in the future.
 - At the beginning of the planning process (e.g., bicycle, pedestrian, transit, freight, utilities, etc.).
 - In cooperation with planning partners.
 - To identify creative solutions to sustain and expand mobility in their community.

The outcome of this partnership will deliver projects that improve economic competitiveness, access to work, and overall quality of life for residents and visitors to their community.

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COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS

- PennDOT Connects begins when a project begins
- Connects is about completing the Project Initiation Form (PIF)
- Connects is just something that the District does

WHAT IS VISIONING?



A Planning Technique:

- Emphasizes community assets and desires rather than issues and needs.
- Focuses on visualization and holding the perspective of what's possible.
- It's part of the larger activity of strategic planning
- It produces a product the vision statement.



EXAMPLE VISION STATEMENT

Vision ideas from a small PA borough association:

- A town known for small business charm and gathering places.
- A business-friendly environment and a diverse business corridor.
- A place where neighbors meet and share life together supported by a diverse local business community.




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A SENSE OF PLACE


- *The Guide for Developing IIJA/BIL Grant Proposals* provides a step-by-step approach to preparing for and pursuing federal grants.
- PennDOT Connects Assistance complements services provided by MPOs/RPOs.






EXAMPLES OF AVAILABLE ASSISTANCE

- Provide registration help in Grants.gov and SAM for federal grants or different PA portals.
- Prepare a grant outlook for identified projects.
- Align potential funding sources with desired projects.







AVAILABLE ASSISTANCE FOR STEP 1 1. Prepare Grant Proposal Strategy Align project objectives to grant program goals. Develop high-level outline of project (a "sell sheet"). Provide NOFO summaries and submission checklists. Align project objectives to relevant local and regional planning documents.


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
AVAILABLE ASSISTANCE FOR STEP 2

2. Secure Critical Support

- Show how the project satisfies and achieves the NOFO's criteria.
- Highlight benefits to supporters.
- Provide template Letters of Support.







AVAILABLE ASSISTANCE FOR STEP 5

5. Review/ Quality Assure Grant Proposal

- Review project narratives, budget narratives, supplementary materials, and graphics.
- Review draft grant packages.
- Conduct application completeness checks.



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AVAILABLE ASSISTANCE FOR STEP 6

6. Submit Grant Proposal

- Provide summary of post-award requirements.
- Provide submission markups for resubmission, if/when desired.
- Assist with post-award project implementation planning.





WHAT IS ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION?





















"THESE ROADS ARE KILLING ME!"


