The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has completed the 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) after a two-year process involving technical analysis, public and stakeholder outreach, and collaborative planning.

The final plan looks ahead 20 years and establishes a multimodal strategic direction for Pennsylvania's transportation network. The plan reviews current and future transportation trends along with national planning factors established by federal funding laws.

How is the Final Plan Used?

The goals and objectives will guide state and regional planning and project programming processes such as PennDOT's 12-Year Program, which includes a fiscally constrained list of funded projects that will be delivered over the next 12 years. Successful implementation is tracked through the biennial Transportation Performance Report, which provides a performance summary of Pennsylvania's multimodal transportation system. The plan is also used as a guide for the planning regions across the state.

Goals



Enhance safety and security for both motorized and non-motorized modes throughout Pennsylvania's transportation system.

Strengthen transportation mobility to meet the increasingly dynamic needs of Pennsylvania residents, businesses, and visitors.

Improve transportation access and equity throughout Pennsylvania.

Strengthen Pennsylvania transportation's resilience to climate change and other risks and reduce transportation's environmental impacts.

Improve the condition and performance of transportation assets.

Structure transportation funding and finance approaches that allocate sufficient resources for system safety, maintenance, preservation, and improvement.



Plan Implementation

PennDOT is responsible for advancing the plan's strategic directions. A short-term action plan has been developed to track implementation and establish a systemic approach to the reporting, follow-through, and communications of the plan.

Public and stakeholder outreach continues to play a key role in the plan's implementation. Public feedback on the implementation process will be requested on a recurring basis through the State Transportation Commission's biennial survey and reported on in conjunction with the development of the Transportation Performance Report.
