Pennsylvania 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) is updating the 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) along with its Freight Movement Plan (FMP). Both plans are in the final stages of a two-year process involving technical analysis, public and stakeholder outreach, and collaborative planning. The plans are scheduled for adoption before the end of the year.

The purpose of the LRTP is to look ahead 20 years and establish a multimodal strategic direction for Pennsylvania's transportation network. The planning team reviews current and future transportation trends along with national planning factors established by federal funding laws.

How is the LRTP Used?

The final goals and objectives will guide state and regional planning and project programming processes such as PennDOT's [12-Year Program](#), which includes a fiscally constrained list of funded projects will be delivered over the next 12 years. Successful implementation is tracked through the biennial [Transportation Performance Report](#), which provides a snapshot of the state of the multimodal transportation system. The plan is also used as a guide for the planning regions across the state.

Next Steps


