The Wayne County Commissioners will receive sealed bids on a single prime contract project until 4:00 PM prevailing time on Wednesday July 1st, 2020 at the office of the Commissioners on the Third Floor of the Court House Annex at 925 Court Street, Honesdale, PA 18431. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud during the regular meeting of the Commissioners that begins at 10:30 AM on Thursday July 2nd, 2020. Bid

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packages including drawings and specifications may be obtained at the above address or by contacting the Commissioners' Office at (570) 253-5970 extension 4050. A \$20.00 non-refundable fee is required for the bid packages. Checks or money orders are to be payable to the Wayne County Commissioners. In addition, a \$9 fee for USPS shipping is also required. **Bids are invited on the following:**  
The base bid work includes the removal and replacement of 7,444 square feet of EPDM membrane roofing including all flashing and an estimated 320 square feet of rigid insulation. The alternate bid work includes the construction of wood truss framing including standard peaked trusses over 2,400 square feet, of the building, shed truss over a 672 square foot office area and shed trusses over a 4,425 square foot processing area. The project will include plywood sheathing of the trusses and gable ends, approximately 79 square of asphalt shingled roofing, along with flashing, drip edge, ventilated soffit, gable end vents, and a gutter and down spout system. Gable ends will be covered with vinyl siding.

The sealed bid must be marked "WAYNE COUNTY RECYCLING CENTER ROOF REPLACEMENT." A certified check or bank draft payable to Wayne County, or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder, and an acceptable Surety in an amount equal to 10% of the total Bid, shall be submitted with each bid.
