# Approved Project Updates

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# The Rapid Bridge Replacement Project

- **Board Action:** Approved September 2013
- **Procurement Status:**
  - In February 2014, five teams submitted statements of qualification
  - 3 or 4 teams will be shortlisted in mid-March for the RFP
  - PennDOT expects to select preferred proposal fall 2014
  - Construction expected to begin in summer 2015.
- **Benefit to the Commonwealth:** Replacement of 550-650 structurally deficient bridges.

- **Commonwealth Bridge Partners:** John Laing Investments, Fluor, American Bridge Company, Traylor Bros. Inc., Joseph B. Fay Co., STV Incorporated and Infrastructure and Industrial Constructors;

- **Plenary Walsh Keystone Partners:** Plenary Group, The Walsh Group, Granite Construction Company, HDR Engineering, HNTB Corporation and Infrastructure Corporation of America;

# Sponsorship and Advertising Program

- **Board Action:** Approved January 2013
- **Procurement Status:** Contract Awarded December 2013
- **Private Partner:** Travelers Marketing
- **Benefit to the Commonwealth:** Raise revenue and offset cost of free service patrols, rest areas & welcome centers, 511 and other PennDOT and PA Turnpike services and programs.

## 511 Traffic and Traveler Information

- **Board Action:** Approved January 2013
- **Procurement Status:** Contract Awarded
- **Private Partner:** Information Logistics
- **Benefit to the Commonwealth:** Info Logistics will develop, operate and maintain the next gen 511 System for PennDOT with added functionality including hands free, eyes free notifications.

# Wireless Telecom Partnership

- **Board Action:** Approved September 2013
- **Procurement Status:** A RFQ will be advertised in spring 2014
- **Benefit to the Commonwealth:** Receive revenue from telecom companies leasing space on existing PennDOT assets while also improving wireless coverage for emergency response and PennDOT operations including Intelligent Transportations Systems (ITS) network.

# Truck Permitting and Routing System

- **Board Action:** Approved September 2013
- **Procurement Status:** A RFP is expected to be advertised in spring 2014.
- **Benefit to the Commonwealth:** Procure a new Automated Permit Routing Analysis System (APRAS) to manage application processing, route generation, route review and permit issuance of special hauling permits.
