



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

SR 0400, Section A47 (Baum Boulevard) – Approximately 300 feet East of Morewood Avenue to South Euclid Avenue. Work being performed includes roadway patches, drainage and utility valve adjustments, full width milling, paving, and line striping operations.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Mid to Late May 2021
 - Roadway Patches
 - Utility Work
 - Consisting of drainage and valve adjustments
 - Primarily weekday working hours, Mon. - Fri., 7am to 5pm
 - Working hours may vary depending on operations
 - No work will take place between 9pm to 7am

- June 2021
 - Paving Operations
 - Phase 1 and 2 as seen under the Restrictions & Detour Section
 - Primarily weekday working hours, Mon. - Fri., 7am to 5pm
 - Working hours may vary depending on operations
 - No work will take place between 9pm to 7am

- Tentatively work is to be complete prior to July 4, 2021

RESTRICTIONS & DETOURS



Phase 1 – Baum Blvd. from Morewood Ave. to S. Graham St.



- Crews will complete single lane milling and paving operations along Route 380, Baum Blvd.
-  Westbound traffic will be detoured onto S. Graham St., Right onto Center Ave.
-  Eastbound Traffic will remain on Route 380, Baum Blvd.
- Work will be completed over two weeks during this phase

Phase 2 – Baum Blvd. from S. Graham St. to S. Euclid Ave.



- Crews will complete single lane milling and paving operations along Route 380, Baum Blvd.
-  Westbound traffic will be detoured onto S. Beatty St., Right onto Center Ave.
-  Eastbound Traffic will remain on Route 380, Baum Blvd.
- Work will be completed over two weeks during this phase
