

 - Provide ADA compliant pedestrian access between Hazelwood, Hays and West Homestead neighborhoods.






Proposed Project

SR 8059 Pedestrian Walkway

- Replace two sets of concrete steps south of Glenwood Bridge with ADA compliant pedestrian walkway.
- Walkway will be constructed with 5'-0" wide cement concrete sidewalk with 54" pedestrian railing with protective fence.
- Walkway will be built on Geosynthetic Reinforced Soil Slope.








Proposed Project

SR 837 Pedestrian Ramp

- Replace two sets of steps, one west of Baldwin Road and the other adjacent to SR 837 east of the interchange with an elevated ADA compliant pedestrian ramp.
- Ramp will be constructed with 5'-0" wide cement concrete sidewalk with 54" pedestrian railing with protective fence.




SR 837 PEDESTRIAN RAMP TYPICAL SECTION NTS

Traffic Control During Construction

Construction of SR 8059 Pedestrian Walkway

- During construction of the SR 8059 Pedestrian Walkway, pedestrians will be detoured to the steps on the east side of Glenwood Bridge.
- Vehicular traffic will be temporarily reduced to one lane on ramp (SR 8059 Ramp A) to SR 885 South.





Traffic Control During Construction


Construction of SR 837 Pedestrian Ramp

- During construction of the SR 837 Pedestrian Ramp the existing steps west of Baldwin Road will be closed.
- The pedestrian detour will follow Baldwin Road, Glass Run Road, off ramp for SR 885 South, and newly constructed SR 8059 Pedestrian Walkway.
- Vehicular traffic will be maintained along Baldwin Road and Mifflin Road but shifted away from work zone area that is between the two roadways.

Construction Schedule

- Project to be awarded in Spring 2020.
- Construction to start Summer 2020 and be completed in Spring 2021.
