PennDOT Juniata County Maintenance work schedule for the week of October 24 to October 28

Mifflintown, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Juniata County Maintenance announces the following work schedule for the week of October 24 to October 28 weather permitting. Motorists should travel with extra caution in these and all work areas. Motorists should be aware that due to the nature of highway maintenance and emergency work, crews could be working on any highway at any time of the day or night.

The following work is scheduled to be completed by contractor, weather permitting:

Glenn O. Hawbaker – State Route 0075 – Contractor will continue scratch and wearing course at Site 1, from Honey Grove to Pleasant View (segments 0340/0000 to 0420/0000) on Saturday, October 22nd and then Monday, October 24th through the rest of the week. All work is weather dependent. Be alert for construction vehicles entering and exiting construction areas. Motorists are advised to watch for slow moving and stopped vehicles through the entire work zone. Motorists are advised to be cautious when traveling through the work zone and to obey the posted speed limit. Targeted end date is 11/1/16.

Glenn O. Hawbaker – State Route 0035 – Contractor will be excavating for approach slabs and forming and pouring sleeper slabs. Contractor will also be pouring parapets. All work is weather dependent. Be alert for construction vehicles entering and exiting construction areas. Motorists are advised to watch for slow moving and stopped vehicles through the entire work zone. Motorists are advised to be cautious when traveling through the work zone and to obey the posted speed limit. Targeted end date is 11/1/16.
