PennDOT Mifflin County Maintenance work schedule for the week of October 24 to October 28

Lewistown, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Mifflin County Maintenance announces the following work schedule for the week of October 24 to October 28 weather permitting. Motorists should travel with extra caution in these and all work areas. Motorists should be aware that due to the nature of highway maintenance and emergency work, crews could be working on any highway at any time of the day or night.

Bridge Beam Repair

- State Route 1012

Sign Repairs

- Various State Routes

Mowing and Litter Pickup

- State Route 0305

Crack Sealing

- State Route 0522

The following work is scheduled to be completed by contractor, weather permitting:

Glenn O. Hawbaker – Various State Routes – The contractor will finish milling the roadway full width on State Route 0655 in Belleville (segments 0140/1300 to 0180/0000) on Monday, October 24th and begin scratch/wearing course on Tuesday, October 25th through the rest of week. The contractor will also finish placing wearing course on State Route 0103, Site 2 towards Granville (segments 0550/0000 to 0490/0000) on Saturday, October 22nd. All work is weather dependent. Be alert for construction vehicles entering and exiting construction areas. Motorists are advised to watch for slow moving and stopped vehicles through the entire work zone. Motorists are advised to be cautious when traveling through the work zone and to obey the posted speed limit. Targeted end date is 11/1/16.
