PennDOT Elk County Maintenance Work Schedule for the Week of April 15

Clearfield, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced the following schedule of maintenance activities in Elk County the week of April 15. PennDOT performs year-round maintenance in its mission to provide a safe, efficient transportation system, and the scope of work in Elk County for the coming week is as follows:

Bridge Maintenance & Cleaning

- Route 219 in Ridgway and Horton townships. Monday, April 15, and Tuesday, April 16. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 255 in the City of St. Marys, Jay and Fox townships. Monday, April 15, and Tuesday, April 16. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 2003 (Toby Road) in Horton Township. Monday, April 15, through Wednesday, April 17. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 2011 (Brandy Camp Road) in Horton Township. Tuesday, April 16, and Wednesday, April 17. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 948 in Ridgway Borough, Fox, Highland, and Ridgway townships. Wednesday, April 17, and Thursday, April 18. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 120 in the City of St. Marys and Ridgway Borough. Wednesday, April 17, and Thursday, April 18. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 2010 (Eshbach Road) in the City of St. Marys. Wednesday, April 17, and Thursday, April 18. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 1005 in (Theresia Street) in the City St. Marys. Wednesday, April 17, and Thursday, April 18. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 1003 (Washington Street) in the City of St. Marys. Wednesday, April 17 through Friday, April 19. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.
- Route 1001 (Windfall Road/Glenn Hazel Road) in the City of St. Marys and Jones Township. Thursday, April 18, and Friday, April 19. Flaggers in the roadway will provide traffic control during daylight hours.

Pennsylvania has some of the oldest bridges in the country, with an age of more than 50 years on average. Preventive maintenance is vital in extending the life of the structures. As such, PennDOT maintenance crews perform some bridge deck patching and structural repairs.

PennDOT urges motorists to exercise caution in these and all work zones to ensure their safety and the safety of county maintenance staff.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions, emergencies, or other unforeseen interruptions.
