


#### **BRIDGE AND ROADWAY ASSETS - STATEWIDE**


#### **BRIDGE AND ROADWAY ASSETS – DISTRICT 9-0**





  - 2022 vs 2021 Maintenance costs
    - Sealcoat Oil 16% increase
    - Sealcoat Stone 25% increase
    - Salt prices 15% increase
- Available funding in 2023
  - TIP funds increased 41.4% between 2023 and 2021 TIPs due to Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)




