Roadway





INFLATION IMPACTS

- Inflation impacts in 2022:
 - Bid Prices
 - 9.3% increase
 - 2022 vs 2021 Construction Season Prices (Based on average prices April – October)
 - Asphalt Index adjustments 45.5% increase
 - Diesel Index prices 95.5% increase
 - 2022 vs 2021 Maintenance costs
 - Sealcoat Oil 16% increase
 - Sealcoat Stone 25% increase
 - Salt prices 15% increase
- Available funding in 2023
 - TIP funds increased 41.4% between 2023 and 2021 TIPs due to Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)









Funds may not be used on roadways previously built with LAR funds to:

- Resurface
- Rehabilitate
- Upgrade
- Improve Safety
