

Pedalcycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee – Duties

The Pennsylvania Pedalcycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee was established in 1995 by Act 72 of the State Legislature.

The Committee consists of 15 members as follows:

- Secretary of Transportation
- Secretary of Conservation and Natural Resources
- Chairman and Minority Chairman of the Senate Transportation Committee
- Chairman and Minority Chairman of the House Transportation Committee
- Nine public members
 - Appointed by the Governor for a term of three years
 - One member representing the Bicycle Federation of Pennsylvania
 - One member representing the League of American Bicyclists
 - One member representing the United States Cycling Federation
 - One member representing a statewide rail-trail organization in this Commonwealth
 - One member representing the Eastern Paralyzed Veterans Association
 - One member representing the general public
 - One member representing the Western Pennsylvania Wheelmen
 - One member representing the Bicycle Coalition of the Delaware Valley
 - One member representing an established pedestrian advocacy group organized within this Commonwealth

The Committee is mandated to meet at least annually. At the Committee's discretion, it may hold regular scheduled meetings. All meetings of the Committee are open to the public. It shall have the power and duty to advise and comment on all phases of cycling and pedestrian program activities being undertaken or financially assisted by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and agencies of state government.
