This memo is to provide guidance on the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program for all federally funded aviation projects. Effective immediately, this memo supersedes the January 12, 2015 DBE Program Guidance Memorandum.

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Based on the findings from the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) DBE Compliance Review Report issued May 22, 2014, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Bureau of Aviation has taken a number of critical steps to ensure that the Bureau of Aviation personnel and state block grant airports have adequate and consistent knowledge about the United States Department of Transportation's (USDOT) DBE Program. This includes the documentation needed to substantiate DBE commitments. The DBE Program's overall objective is to provide opportunities for DBE's to compete fairly on aviation contracts.

In collaboration with PennDOT's Bureau of Equal Opportunity, the Bureau of Aviation provided DBE training to all state block grant airports. The training covered roles and responsibilities of airport sponsors, consultants and bureau personnel. Process flows and required DBE documentation were discussed in detail.

To emphasize the importance of the required DBE documentation, attached is each respective form. In addition, an explanation regarding the intent of each form is located in the attached briefing, Summary of Documentation.
