

- \* Major impacts to businesses






## Project History and Need

  - \* 5000-foot long elevated highway structure
  - \* Fair condition
- \* Brandywine River Bridge identified Aug 2014
  - \* 2000-foot river crossing
  - \* Fair condition





## Project History and Need

- \* Identified other corridor needs
  - \* Deteriorating median barrier
  - \* Substandard guardrail
  - \* Age of original concrete pavement
  - \* Outdated signage and lighting
  - \* Expanded scope Fall 2014





### Project Vision

- \* 30 years maintenance free
  - Intermittent maintenance has been constant
  - \* Nearly 20% of all High Priority Work Orders



Wilmington Viaduct Limits








