








Project Staging Change – Start construction with Stages 3 & 4 County Line Road Bridge originally planned for replacement in Stage 3






Project Staging Change – Start with Stages 3 & 4 New box culvert cast & ready for placement






Traffic Control Plan – Stages 5 thru 8 (670 days) County Line Road Westbound Detour






Traffic Control Plan – Stages 1 & 2 (401 days) County Line Road Westbound Detour
