Route 11/15 Rock Slope Safety Project

Planning For a Safer Commute

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Numerous regional projects will be completed in preparation of the Route 11/15 closure (refer to graphic on the right)

Key Route 22/322 safety and speed reduction measures include:

- Bituminous overlays, concrete pavement patching, and surface grinding of the existing roadway to restore the skid resistance level
- New roadside signs and guide rail to meet current 0 criteria for reflectivity and roadside safety
- Additional pavement markings and delineation to enhance 0 roadway visibility such as top and side mounted delineators on the existing median barrier, flexible delineator posts along the roadside, and snow-plowable raised pavement markers next to paint lines
 - Speed limit pavement marking legends on the pavement throughout the lane section of Route 22/322 between Route 11/15 and the Clarks Ferry Bridge and in advance of the horizontal curve near the railroad overpass in Dauphin Borough
 - A curve ahead warning sign and truck roll over sign with wig wags (i.e. alternating flashing yellow lights) in advance of the horizontal curve near the railroad overpass in Dauphin Borough
 - During the Route 11/15 closure, Speed Display Signs will be installed both eastbound and westbound along Route 22/322 to help maintain the posted speed
 - PennDOT is working with the Pennsylvania State Police to increase enforcement of the Route 22/322 posted speed limit during the Route 11/15 closure

Regional signalized intersections will be observed and retimed within 3 days of implementation of the 90 day detour to accommodate changes in traffic patterns

Marysville Borough and PennDOT are planning to implement safety improvements along the Local and Emergency Access Route
