Spider Bites

- 1. Wash area with soap and water
- 2. Apply cool compress
- 3. Apply antibiotic
- 4. Take medication for pain
- 5. Watch for signals of an allergic reaction

Seek medical attention for:

- Suspect bite to be from black widow or brown recluse spider
- Deep blue/purple area around bite surrounded by white ring and outer red ring
- Body rash
- Muscle tightness, spasms, stiffness
- Abdominal pain
- Headache
- Fever
- Chills
- Nausea and vomiting
- Joint pain
- Lack of appetite
- General feeling of sickness
